Subject: Request for Local Public Hearing – State Corporation Commission (SCC) Case No. PUR-2026-00050, Dominion Energy's Proposed Charlottesville-Gordonsville 230 kV Rebuild/Expansion Project

Dear Clerk of the State Corporation Commission,

I am filing this request for hearing as an interested person in SCC Case No. PUR-2026-00050, concerning Dominion Energy Virginia's proposed Charlottesville-Gordonsville 230 kV Rebuild/Expansion Project.

My interest in this proceeding is that I [live / own property / work / regularly travel / have family or community ties] in or near [neighborhood, road, community, business, or area], that may be affected by this proposed transmission line project.

The specific action I seek is for the SCC to convene a local public hearing proximate to the affected area before deciding whether to approve the Application.

The legal basis for this request includes the SCC's June 2, 2026, Order for Notice and Comment in Case No. PUR-2026-00050, which allows interested persons to request a hearing, and Virginia Code Section 56-46.1, which governs SCC review, notice, and hearings for certain electric transmission line projects.

A hearing should be conducted because this project may:

- Adversely impact residents and communities through structure, locations, height, and color;
- Adversely impact natural, scenic, cultural, and historic resources;
- Disrupt residents and communities during construction; and
- Cause health and long-term exposure impacts.

A local public hearing would address community concerns regarding the necessity for full consideration of alternatives and mitigation of impacts including, but not limited to, lower-impact alternatives, targeted undergrounding, or other meaningful mitigation have been adequately considered. A local public hearing would help ensure that affected

residents have a meaningful opportunity to understand the proposal, ask questions, and be heard before the SCC makes a final decision.

For the reasons stated above, I respectfully request that the SCC convene a local public hearing proximate to the affected area.

Submit this request on or before July 8, 2026:

- Request for a public hearing in writing.
- All filings shall refer to Case No. PUR-2026-00050

1. a precise statement of the filing party's interest in the proceeding;
2. a statement of the specific action sought to the extent then known;
3. a statement of the legal basis for such action; and
4. a precise statement why a hearing should be conducted in this matter.
